### **Criteria for Selection**

a. Complete process of examination shall be an elimination process. Candidates qualifying in all papers of previous stage shall be eligible to appear for test in the next stage i.e. candidates qualifying in each paper of Stage I shall be eligible to appear for test in Stage II and thereafter, candidates qualifying in each paper of Stage II

shall be eligible to appear for test in Stage III. This vis-à-vis implies that if any of the candidates does not qualify any paper of a particular stage, he/ she shall not qualify for the next stage.

- a) Only such candidates who qualify in all papers of each stage viz. Stage I, Stage II and Stage III shall be considered while preparation of the final merit list.
- b) Final merit list of the qualified candidates shall be prepared by calculation of final marks in the following manner:

- c) After arranging the candidates in order of merit as at (d) above, number of candidates to be declared successful shall be equal to the number of vacancy in each category.
- d) In the event of any vacancy notified for recruitment remains unfilled only due to nonjoining of selected candidate, the next candidate in the merit list shall be considered for appointment. However, appointment of such candidate shall be only on the ground of refusal of promotion / declining offer of appointment and no wait list or approved panel shall be maintained.

NOTE: Pattern and Syllabus for trade test for promotion to Staff Car Driver (Grade-II) and Staff Car Driver (Grade-I) shall continue to be same as provided in Directorate's letter no. 17-2/2-PE-II dated 20.12.1993.
